- What: Unmissable stone bridge where the iconic Ella-Kandy train passes by!
- When: Plan to be there when the train passes. Ask a local what time! Tip: it often runs late ②
- How much: free!



Nildiya Pokuna Ella

- What: gorgeous 5,000 y/o cave system with a crystal clear pool. You need to be in moderately good shape. This one is for the adventurous!
- When: 10 am 3 pm
- How much: 3,000 rupees not including tip

General Tips

- Ella is small and walkable, but you'll need to hire a tuktuk to visit the main attractions.

- What: Ella Rock = long & challenging. Little Adam's Peak = short & easy. <u>Guided tour to Ella Rock here.</u>
- When: Ella Rock for sunrise, Little Adam's peak for sunset.
- How much: free *unless you hire someone*



Dunhinda Waterfall

- What: Beautiful waterfall! Don't carry food with you... MONKEYS! Google Maps sends you the wrong way. Stay on the main road and follow the signs.
- **When**: 7 am 5 pm
- How much: \$0.90 p/p
